EXHIBITOR INFORMATION

Obstacles: Obstacles will meet the specifications for obstacles in the current edition of the Regulations for Agility.

<u>**Crating Space:**</u> Limited with no ex-pens allowed. Crate in designated areas only. No crating is allowed in the back hallway behind the men's room. See additional information in Agility Trial Best Practices addendum.

Warm-Ups: The warm-up area is found in the lunchroom/crating area. It contains a regulation agility jump and is available to all exhibitors.

Dogs Eligible to Enter: As it states in the Regulations for Agility Trials, Chapter 1, Section 3, All dogs fifteen (15) months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or that have AKC Limited Registration, Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP) or an AKC Canine Partners listing number, or approved Foundation Stock Services (FSS) breeds are eligible to participate except bitches in heat, aggressive dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury, or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance. Dogs or registerable breeds with accepted foreign registration numbers are eligible to participate.

Safety/Behavior: The safety of the dogs is our primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely. Exhibitors should follow their veterinarian's recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations. Exhibitors are responsible for ensuring that their dogs are in the proper physical and mental condition to run safely.

Liability: It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor, exhibitor's dogs and/or children that create an unnecessary disturbance or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the trial committee, be asked to leave the show site. In such case, no refund of any fees paid will be made. St. Paul Dog Training Club and its agents, employees, etc., will assume no responsibilities for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors or handlers, or to any of their dogs or property and further assumes no responsibility for injury to children.

St. Paul Dog Training Club reserves the right to decline entries for cause and may remove any dog on account of aggression. No one shall have any recourse or claim against St. Paul Dog Training Club or any official thereof.

Leashes: All dogs must be on leash at all times when on the trial grounds except when in the designated warm-up area or competing on the course.

<u>Ringside:</u> Dogs may arrive any time prior to judging if the dog has a valid temporary or permanent jump height card. Otherwise they must be available for measuring prior to the start of their class. All dogs not needed for further judging may leave the trial. Judges are not required to wait for dogs. The owner of each dog is solely responsible for having it ready at ringside when it is to be judged.

<u>Shoes:</u> Please preserve the matting by wearing clean athletic shoes. No spiked shoes of any kind are allowed.

Overnight Parking: No overnight parking is allowed at the trial site. No parking is available for campers, motorhomes or RVs unless they fit in a standard parking spot.

INSTRUCTIONS

Handlers whose dogs measure into the 8" through 20" regular jump height divisions may opt to enter in a higher or 24-choice height division for all Regular titling classes, but not in a division lower than their proper height division. Dogs who measure into the 24" regular jump height division may not enter 24-choice. Dogs entered in the Preferred classes must compete at the required jump height and may not compete in a jump height division higher or lower than their proper height division.

All dogs that have not been officially measured for an Agility Jump Height Card may still compete; however, they must be measured by a Judge of record, an Agility Field Representative, or a Volunteer Measuring Official, prior to running. If measured by the Judge of record, that measurement will be valid for this trial or back-to-back trials only. If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog(s) measured prior to running.

Dogs listed in the AKC Canine PartnersSM program may be eligible to enter all-breed AKC agility trials at the club's option. These dogs should be listed as All American Dog and must include their AKC number on the entry form and check the AKC No. box.

Junior Handlers should enter their Junior Handler number on the front of this form. Should you not have your Junior Handler number. it may be obtained from the American Kennel Club (919) 233-9767. Entering a Mixture of Regular and Preferred Classes Within the Same Trial Weekend – Multiple Jump Heights Within the Same Trial Day

Effective January 1, 2020, exhibitors may enter a mixture of both Regular and Preferred classes on the same trial day and/or during a trial weekend. Any mixture of Regular and Preferred classes is allowed. Please note that if a dog qualifies in Regular Master Standard and Preferred Master JWW (or vice versa) on the same trial day, then NO Double Q shall be earned toward either the MACH or PACH title. The Double Q still requires that Standard Agility and Jumpers With Weaves be either both Regular OR both Preferred on the same trial day.

Additionally, within the same Regular or Preferred classes, a dog may now be entered in multiple jump heights within the same trial day. For example, the same dog may now be entered in 20-inch Master STD/JWW while also entered in 24C-inch Premier STD/JWW on the same trial day.

A separate entry form must be submitted when the same dog is being entered in a mixture of Regular and Preferred and/or different jump heights within the same trial weekend thereby clearly indicating which class(es) and/or jump heights belong together for each trial day of the weekend.

Entering For Exhibition Only (FEO)

As of January 1, 2020, For Exhibition Only may be offered at the option of the host club. FEO will be offered on a one-year pilot basis in order to give AKC time to evaluate its impact. FEO will allow exhibitors to work with their dogs in a trial environment. FEO is only allowed in the Time 2 Beat and FAST classes. FEO will be of value to new exhibitors or exhibitors that are having difficulty with a specific obstacle and/or ring environment. Competitors must enter in T2B and/or FAST. Participation in FEO is non-qualifying.

- FEO runs are treated as trial entries. The exhibitor must enter the class(es) (T2B and/or FAST) prior to the closing date, pay class entry fee(s) and the Trial Secretary must record the entry in the Trial Catalog as part of the results for that class. FEO does not need to be noted on the entry form; the handler will declare the day of the show.
- Dogs may be entered in any jump height for FEO runs. If entered in an ineligible jump height, the team is committed to FEO for that run and must declare FEO on the start line. Day of show jump height changes are not allowed.
- Dogs may be entered in any level of FAST (Novice, Open, Excellent, Master). If the dog is not eligible for the level entered, the team is committed to FEO for that run and must declare FEO on the start line. Day of show level changes are not allowed.

- The exhibitor must declare FEO in the ring prior to leading out. FEO may be declared earlier (ex. when checking in at the gate board).
- Toys are allowed in the ring
 - o Toys must be non-audible
 - o Toys may not leave the handler's hand
 - o Toys that roll freely cannot be used
- Food/treats are not allowed in the ring
- FEO should be utilized for the benefit of the dog and not as a punitive correction. Harsh verbal and /or physical corrections shall not be tolerated. Any determination of harshness by the judge shall be immediately whistled and the handler will be dismissed from the ring.
- A judge must monitor the entire run. Judges can stop a run at any time

Fix and Go On (FNG)

•

As of January 1, 2020, Fix and Go On will be offered on a one-year pilot basis in order to give AKC time to evaluate its impact. FNG allows exhibitors to immediately reattempt an obstacle at any time while on course when the dog's performance of an obstacle is not to their expectation. This allows the dog to successfully complete the obstacle then finish the course or leave the ring on a positive note. Using FNG will result in a non-qualifying score.

Fix and Go On is not pre-entered; rather, it occurs during the course of the run.

SPDTC <u>is committed to the safety of all competitors, workers</u>, volunteers and our Judge. We will be implementing the following guidelines:

- Com<u>munication After trial closing, co</u>nfirmed participants will receive instructions on how to opt into trial information, such as group texts_or other electronic communication options.
- Masks are mandatory and must be worn at all times in the building. This includes wearing a mask while running your dog. If this changes before the trial, exhibitors will be notified.
- No external spectators will be allowed at this Trial. Only trial participants will be allowed in the building.
- Limited indoor crating will be allowed however please adhere to the 6 ft social distancing guidelines. SPDTC reserves the right to move anyone who may be too close to another competitor. You are welcome to crate in your car if you feel the weather is favorable for you.
- No food will be provided at this trial. Plan to go out for lunch or bring your own. There are a couple of restaurants in the area that you could use all within walking distance.
- Course maps will be emailed the night before and/or posted on the Trial and/or Secretary websites. Plan to utilize these electronic copies or take pictures.
- Master / Excellent classes will be broken down into two categories (big dogs and little dogs). Course walk-throughs will be held for each category and walk-throughs will be limited to 25 exhibitors at a time. Additional walk-throughs may be added if necessary.
- Course design will facilitate smooth entry and exit to minimize interaction. Floor markers will guide participants on where/how to line up to enter the ring for a class.
- Leash Options:
 - The Volunteer will use a grabber to move the leash to the end of the course. The grabber will be wiped down after each use.

- Per AKC the leash may be put in your pocket, around your neck or around your waist. However, if the dog grabs the leash during the run, it will be scored as an "E".
- Score sheets will not be available individually.
- Trial outcomes will be emailed to competitors following competition.
- We encourage Volunteer Sign Up ahead of time using the published Google Doc link.
- MACH/PACH bars will be given out at this trial. However, per AKC guidelines, no cakes will be allowed.
- No personal chairs will be allowed.
- There will be a door and parking lot monitor on premise.
- We encourage use of the numerous hand sanitizing stations and thorough hand washing techniques often during the Trial. Please report any supply issues to the Trial Committee for prompt attention.
- SPDTC is committed to sanitizing/disinfecting as much as possible throughout the trial, particularly at the end of each day. This may include but is not limited to spraying or wiping down:
