****BOUNCED CHECK FEES: A \$30 fee will be charged for all bounced checks. Repeat offenders will have to pay with a money order.**

Entry changes, additions, corrections or cancellations **MUST** be received in writing or by email prior to the final closing date.

REFUNDS: Refunds for females that come in season and injured dogs after closing date will be refunded (minus a \$10.00 administration fee per day) if a veterinarian certificate is presented to the trial secretary prior to the start of judging. A full refund will be reimbursed to any entrant whose entry is replaced by a Wait-Listed entry. Refunds will not be issued because of riots, civil disturbances or other acts beyond the control of management if it is impossible to open or complete the show. No refunds for overpayments of \$10 or less. Entry fees shall not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by vet or judge, or barred from competition by action of the trial committee.

AKC DNA PROFILE NUMBER IS REQUIRED

The BMDCA requires each entrant to provide a valid AKC DNA Profile Number for the dog entered on the Official Entry Form at time of entry. Failure to meet these requirements will render the dog ineligible to enter the event. This may result in the loss of all awards earned at the event, as well as subject the entrant to possible disciplinary action by the AKC and/or BMDCA, including but not limited to suspension from club privileges and entry of club events. All DNA numbers will be verified by the BMDCA within 30 days after the National Specialty. DNA kits can be obtained from the AKC Online Store at www.akc.org. **DON'T DELAY! STANDARD PROCESSING TIME IS 6-8 WEEKS AFTER RECEIPT!** If it has been more than 8 weeks since the DNA sample was submitted to AKC and you have not received a DNA profile number **AND** need it for your BMDCA Specialty entry, call AKC DNA Operations at 919-816-3508 to obtain a preliminary DNA number (accepted in extenuating circumstances only). Please allow sufficient time for the AKC to receive your sample and call **NO LATER THAN** one week prior to close of entries. Be sure to mention "BMDCA National Specialty" to expedite your request.

Get on US-15 S in Freedom Township from US-15 BUS S 4 (2.4 mi). Follow US-15 S for approximately 50 miles. Follow Rt. 15 Bypass south past Battlefield Shopping Center and the Leesburg Corner outlet shops. After you pass the exit for the Dulles Greenway toll road, take the second Rt. 15 exit, Rt. 15 South towards Warrenton. On Rt. 15 South, turn left at the second traffic light onto Evergreen Mills Road. Follow Evergreen Mills past 2 schools (one on either side) and Masons Lane (on the right). The training facility entrance is the third driveway on the right after Masons Lane. There is a residence in the front of the property. Please use your GPS for more exact directions.

ADDITIONAL SITE INFORMATION

- **CRATING: Please plan on crating in your car. The parking lot is right up against the building so it's a short walk in any weather! Should it get hot, there are some parking spots that are shaded.**
- No cleats of any type may be worn on the field turf. No food on the field turf.
- Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning up after their dog(s) at the site and at the hotels. Any exhibitor failing to do so may be excused without benefit of refund if the Trial Committee deems the exhibitor to be in violation of this requirement. Cleaning supplies and disposal sites will be available at various locations around the show grounds.
- If your dog goes potty anywhere "in" the building (in or out of the ring), you will be charged a \$5 clean up fee that must be paid by you to the facility.
- Parking will be tight and we might ask that you park "tandem" to conserve space. Please be courteous of other cars. Do NOT park on the grass.
- No overnight parking will be allowed at the trial site. Set up will be the morning of the trial only.

HIGH IN TRIAL CALCULATION

Two High in Trial awards shall be offered: One for the Regular classes and one for the Preferred classes. Both HIT awards shall be calculated in the same manner according to a point system. The trial secretary and/or chair will post results where it's easily visible. ALL classes count towards the HIT awards. Points will be calculated as follows:

Each Q5 points
 First Placeadditional 5 points
 Second Placeadditional 3 points
 Third Place additional 2 points
 Fourth Place additional 1 point

Ties will be broken using the results from the STD class. First, the team that Q'd, and second, the team with the most points earned (full seconds under time). If there is still a tie, we will move to the JWW class results (Q and points). Only one HIT shall be awarded for Regular and one for Preferred.

EXHIBITOR INFORMATION

Obstacles: Obstacles will meet the specifications for obstacles in the current edition of the Regulations for Agility. The warm-up area contains a regulation agility jump and is available to all exhibitors.

Dogs Eligible to Enter: As it states in the Regulations for Agility Trials, Chapter 1, Section 3, All dogs fifteen (15) months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or that have AKC Limited Registration, Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP) or an AKC Canine Partners listing number, or approved Foundation Stock Services (FSS) breeds are eligible to participate except bitches in heat, aggressive dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury, or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance. Dogs or registerable breeds with accepted foreign registration numbers are eligible to participate.

Safety/Behavior: The safety of the dogs is our primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely. Exhibitors should follow their veterinarian's recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations. Exhibitors are responsible for ensuring that their dogs are in the proper physical and mental condition to run safely.

Liability: It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor, exhibitor's dogs and/or children that create an unnecessary disturbance or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the trial committee, be asked to leave the show site. In such case, no refund of any fees paid will be made. The club and its agents, employees, etc., will assume no responsibilities for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors or handlers, or to any of their dogs or property and further assumes no responsibility for injury to children. The club reserves the right to decline entries for cause and may remove any dog on account of aggression. No one shall have any recourse or claim against the club or any official thereof.

Leashes: All dogs must be on leash at all times when on the trial grounds except when in the designated warm-up area or competing on the course. While running, there are two options:
Option 1: The Leash Runner will use a "grabber" to move your leash to the end of the course. Your leash will be placed in the bucket.
Option 2: You can place your leash in your pocket, around your neck, or around your waist per AKC. If the dog grabs the leash while running, this will be scored as an "E".

Course Maps: Course maps will be posted the morning of the trial.

Ringside: Dogs may arrive any time prior to judging if the dog has a valid temporary or permanent jump height card. Otherwise they must be available for measuring prior to the start of their class. All dogs not needed for further judging may leave the trial. Judges are not required to wait for dogs. The owner of each dog is solely responsible for having it ready at ringside when it is to be judged.

I (we) agree that the club holding this event has the right to refuse this entry for cause which the club shall deem sufficient. I (we) certify and represent that the dog entered is not a hazard to persons or other dogs. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of this event and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prizes, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the AKC, the event-giving club, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or event secretary and the owner and/or lessor of the premises and any provider of services that are necessary to hold this event and any employees or volunteers of the aforementioned parties, and any AKC approved judge, judging at this event, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or about the event premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim; and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss, injury or damage to this dog.

Additionally, I (we) hereby assume the sole responsibility for and agree to indemnify, defend and save the aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expense (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties for damage because of bodily injuries, including death at any time resulting therefrom, sustained by any person or persons, including myself (ourselves), or on account of damage to property, arising out of or in consequence of my (our) participation in this event, however such, injuries, death or property damage may be caused, and whether or not the same may have been caused or may be alleged to have been caused by the negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees, agents, or any other person. INSTRUCTIONS

Handlers whose dogs measure into the 8" through 20" regular jump height divisions may opt to enter in a higher or 24-choice height division for all Regular titling classes, but not in a division lower than their proper height division. Dogs who measure into the 24" regular jump height division may not enter 24-choice. Dogs entered in the Preferred classes must compete at the required jump height and may not compete in a jump height division higher or lower than their proper height division.

All dogs that have not been officially measured for an Agility Jump Height Card may still compete; however, they must be measured by a Judge of record, an Agility Field Representative, or a Volunteer Measuring Official, prior to running. If measured by the Judge of record, that measurement will be valid for this trial or back-to-back trials only. If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog(s) measured prior to running.

Dogs listed in the AKC Canine PartnersSM program may be eligible to enter all-breed AKC agility trials at the club's option. These dogs should be listed as All American Dog and must include their AKC number on the entry form and check the AKC No. box.

Junior Handlers should enter their Junior Handler number on the front of this form. Should you not have your Junior Handler number, it may be obtained from the American Kennel Club (919) 233-9767. If the Junior Handler is not the owner of the dog identified on the face of this form, what is the relationship of the Junior Handler to the Owner?

Class Changes Effective January 1, 2020

Entering a Mixture of Regular and Preferred Classes Within the Same Trial Weekend – Multiple Jump Heights Within the Same Trial Day

Effective January 1, 2020, exhibitors may enter a mixture of both Regular and Preferred classes on the same trial day and/or during a trial weekend. Any mixture of Regular and Preferred classes is allowed. Please note that if a dog qualifies in Regular Master Standard and Preferred Master JWW (or vice versa) on the same trial day, then NO Double Q shall be earned toward either the MACH or PACH title. The Double Q still requires that Standard Agility and Jumpers With Weaves be either both Regular OR both Preferred on the same trial day.

Additionally, within the same Regular or Preferred classes, a dog may now be entered in multiple jump heights within the same trial day. For example, the same dog may now be entered in 20-inch Master STD/JWW while also entered in 24C-inch Premier STD/JWW on the same trial day.

A separate entry form must be submitted when the same dog is being entered in a mixture of Regular and Preferred and/or different jump heights within the same trial weekend thereby clearly indicating which class(es) and/or jump heights belong together for each trial day of the weekend.

Entering For Exhibition Only (FEO)

- For Exhibition Only may be offered at the option of the host club. FEO will allow exhibitors to work with their dogs in a trial environment. FEO is allowed in all classes. Participation in FEO is non-qualifying.
- FEO runs are treated as trial entries. The exhibitor must enter the class(es) prior to the closing date, pay class entry fee(s) and the Trial Secretary must record the entry in the Trial Catalog as part of the results for that class. FEO does not need to be noted on the entry form; the handler will declare the day of the show.
- Dogs may be entered in any jump height for FEO runs. If entered in an ineligible jump height, the team is committed to FEO for that run and must declare FEO on the start line. Day of show jump height changes are not allowed.
- Dogs may be entered at any level (Novice, Open Excellent or Masters) in FAST, JWW, Standard or Premier classes. If the dog is not eligible for the level entered, the team is committed to FEO for that run and must declare FEO on the start line. Day of show level changes are not allowed.
- The exhibitor must declare FEO in the ring prior to leading out to the scribe and the judge.
- Course time for FEO in Time 2 Beat, JWW, Standard, Premier and ISC will be 45 seconds. FAST courses times for each class/height are as noted in the Regulations.

Fix and Go On (FNG)

Fix and Go On is not pre-entered; rather, it occurs during the course of the run.

FNG allows exhibitors to immediately reattempt an obstacle at any time while on course when the dog's performance of an obstacle is not to their expectation. This allows the dog to successfully complete the obstacle then finish the course or leave the ring on a positive note. Using FNG will result in a non-qualifying score.
